To be a chapter requirements and benefits:

Each chapter will be assessed \$350 USD as an initial registration fee, and \$350 USD each year after for annual dues to the North American chapter. Each chapter may collect dues from its own members as it sees fit.

Dues from International Chapters will primarily be used to maintain their place in the IAOMT website, www.IAOMT.org. All active members of each chapter will be listed in the website, so that patients searching for a dentist or physician in that country will be able to locate them. Members will be welcome to participate in our discussion forums, to communicate with other members of the Academy.

IAOMT will provide a link to your chapter web site, *or you may develop your own area* within the main website, in the International Chapters section.

The IAOMT will send each chapter one copy of any periodical publications, such as our newsletter, “In Vivo”, as each issue is published. Each chapter will be responsible for translation and dissemination of the publications as well as any other materials to its members.

IAOMT will invite all global members to its meetings and seminars, extending the courtesy of registration for the same reduced fee as the North American members, and would appreciate all chapters extending similar courtesies to each other.

All chapters may request and/or offer help or counsel to each other as the need arises, whether for information, legal advice, establishing standards, protocol and courses for Accreditation and Fellowship, etc.

Information about the application process

At present, existing chapters are: Australia, Brazil, Europe, Finland, France, Israel, Italy, Mexico, Netherlands, New Zealand, North America (US and Canada), Sweden, Taiwan, and the United Kingdom (England).

If you are interested in becoming a chapter of the IAOMT, the following application must be filled out and sent to the IAOMT office with the following attachments.

1. Attach all constitution documents registered with governmental bodies, bylaws, and similar material (if any). If you agree with our bylaws and don't already have or desire to create your own, you may sign the statement saying you agree with the principles enumerated in our bylaws. A copy of our current bylaws can be downloaded from our website and you may use it as a guide to create or alter your own bylaws as you desire.
2. Attach a list of members, with address, telephone number, fax number, website url, and email address, for inclusion in the website database. Please keep this list up to date for us.
3. Attach name, address, telephone, fax numbers, and email addresses of the two principal officers for the International Academy to contact.
4. Attach \$350 dollars (us funds) for the first year's dues. (money order, personal check, wire transfer, or MC/Visa accepted).
